SUBJECT: Unite for Good Jobs at Lumen Campaign

We are facing serious challenges at Lumen. It is clear that executives are doing everything in their power to weaken the Union by eliminating jobs and hiring lower wage workers and contractors to replace us. We ask for your leadership in an organizing and mobilizing campaign to fight for our future at Lumen.

With your Local's active engagement, the Unite for Good Jobs at Lumen Campaign will increase union power at Lumen. We will use the CWA triangle and build power on all sides of the CWA Triangle as follows:

• Mobilization and Representation: We mobilize by building our structure, educating ourselves, and taking collective action. Mobilizing improves power at the bargaining table.

- Organizing: We will increase membership in our existing bargaining units by getting co-workers to join the union and build our stewards structure. We will expand into new areas by organizing future members in job titles which are not currently represented.
- Political and Community Action: We will work with community allies to exert state and federal pressure for Good Jobs and Broadband for all. We need investment for broadband build out and accountability for good jobs with workers' rights.
